Official Description:

In the United Nations (UN), the process doesn't stop at the debate; once a resolution has been passed, the world then works towards what has been decided. In the spirit of making real change in our communities, in this year's THIMUN Qatar conference, as part of our MUN Impact initiative, we are holding a competition in which all schools attending the conference are eligible to enter.

THIMUN Qatar aims to become a platform for global impact and change. The competition, *Global Act with Impact Award (GAIA)*, will unite schools participating at THIMUN Qatar to work towards the UN Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs). - Each team will produce a (max) 5 minute video that documents and showcases their work
- A board of judges will select the top 3 teams, whose videos will be played in the closing ceremony, and the top winner will be awarded a prize by THIMUN Qatar. (QAR3,000, QAR 2,000 and QAR 1,000 respectively, in vouchers)

 - Application due December 10th

<u>Result</u>: 5 minute video in which the group states their goal, showcases their service program, with evidence in footage of their planning, action and result.

Judging process:

- 1. Initial deadline All the applications / schools wanting to participate + give a record Deadline for applications to get in as well (just to commit to participating in the project)
- 2. Set a final deadline for all documentation + schools
- 3. Shortlist Top 3 THIMUN Exec and Office do that in the office prior to competition
- 4. Top 3 the videos and a person from each group present to directors and all conference participants vote on the final winner
- 5. All three videos get shown in closing ceremony, and winner receives an award.
- 6. The winning team will be presented with an award + promotion on our website + blog etc..
